The company marketed its products through its consumer catalog, internet site, and two retail stores in the Seattle/Bellevue market. Sold catalog and internet operations to a Canadian game developer.
- VP, General Manager at Gravis, a publicly held company (NASDAQ, VSE, TSE) that designed, developed, manufactured, and marketed entertainment devices for personal computers. Product lines included Joysticks, Game-Pads, Mouse-Sticks, and sound cards. Gravis grew from \$5 million to \$20 million in annual revenue in two years.
